No Food or Drink Allowed in Theater House

Once you are done running your pieces you are free to leave. If things go smoothly and we run ahead of schedule we will get classes up on stage sooner and get you home even earlier!

Dress Rehearsal Arrival Times: Please arrive at least **FIFTEEN** minutes prior to your scheduled time on stage. This is a **FULL** dress rehearsal. Which means dancers will want to wear all of their costumes and have their hair like they plan for the show. Just like the actual recital, young dancer classes (Creative Movement through Level 2) will be sitting with their classes in the audience. When you first come to the theater, find the row of seats that has your child's class and you'll see a nametag for your student's place. For the actual recital we will be asking for **2** parent volunteers that will sit with each class. They will help bring the classes up to the stage for their dances and then back to their seats. You will see parent volunteer sign up sheets posted at the studio. **Please considering helping if able.** Levels 3/4 and up will have assigned dressing rooms back stage.

Make-up: For younger dancers we leave it up to parents. If you would like to do a little make up please do so before coming to the theater. Older dancers should think of heavy street make up. If you have any questions please ask us before we go to the theater and we would be happy to advise.

Hair: Creative Movement through Level 2 should wear their hair pulled up off of their face. Level 3/4's and higher should have hair in full bun (neat and slick back) for ballet pieces. For other dances, they can wear it differently as long as it is still pulled back neatly off their faces. If dancers have a dressing area backstage, costumes maybe left in dressing rooms over night for Friday Recital.

You may also take **non-flash** pictures and videos at the dress rehearsal. This is your time to go crazy. However, **NO** taking pictures or videos during the actual recital performance. It is a huge distraction to your fellow audience members

If you are a parent volunteer, please arrive by 5:50 we want to get you situated with your class place before we open the doors to the public.
